Fashion Film (Introduction level)

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course introduces students to the world of fashion films, the new form of immersive, interactive and digital filmmaking of the twenty-first century.

It will provide students the necessary tools and basic technical skills, from the creative process to the fashion film making.

Participants will be inspired to develop their own ideas and their potential to the fullest. Personal research and observation will be used to analyze contemporary fashion films and students will be required to develop the project of their own Fashion Film based on a personal concept.

This course is intended for students without any academic background in the specific subject area and for students attending their first year of university studies in Art and Design.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

Students will approach the world of Fashion Film through a theoretical, technical and project and production part, which will lead them to the development of a personal Fashion Film project.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The course is open to all students. No academic background in the specific subject area is required.

OUTPUT

Students will be required to develop the project of their own Fashion Film based on a personal concept.

LIST OF MATERIALS AND TOOLS

As well as a theoretical part, in which the multiple facets of fashion films will be studied, the course will provide students the following tools and basic technical skills, from the creative process to the fashion film making:

- Elements of creative process
- Pre-production elements
- Film shooting elements
- Post-production elements

ATTENDANCE POLICY

Class attendance is required for successful completion of the course. Attendance will be taken every class period.

Students should attend every lesson, and try to be in class at least 10 minutes before the beginning of class. On the last day of classes, instructors will issue a **Certificate of successful attendance only to all students who completed at least 80% of the course.**
